COURSES OFFERED & INTAKE CAPACITY

Bachelor of Arts and Science (B.A./B.Sc.)

The undergraduate academic programme shall be of 4(four) years duration (under NEP 2020) with multiple exit options within this period with appropriate certifications namely:

- a) Bachelor's certificate in Discipline upon the successful completion of the First Year (Two Semesters)
- b) Bachelor's Diploma in Discipline upon the successful completion of Second Year (Four semesters)
- c) Bachelor's Degree in Discipline upon the successful completion of Third Year (Six Semesters)
- d) Bachelor's Degree with Honours in a Discipline upon the successful completion of the Fourth year (Eight semesters)

Examinations are held twice a year during an academic session

First/Third/Fifth/Seventh : December-January

Second/Fourth/Sixth/Eighth: May-June

To enhance the quality of the students, Unit Test Examinations are conducted by each and every Departments as per schedule of the respective departments. Departmental Seminars for the fifth and sixth sememster honours students in particular are compulsorily conducted as per convenience of the respective departments.





Procedure for Admission :

Admission is based on merit basis. The candidates must have passed the class XII Examination conducted by the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur or its equivalent examination from a recognised Board/University and must have secured at least the following percentage of marks:

- a) 55% marks in aggregate for general candidates in Science and 50% marks in aggregate for general candidates in Arts and,
- b) 5% relaxation marks is given to SC/ST/National players Et 3% relaxation of marks for NCCEt. NSS Certificate Holders.

Reservation:

- a) 31 % of the seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheuled Tribes, 2% for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes.17% for OBC, 3% for disabled person, 2% for PWD, 2% for Sports persons, 2% for son/daughter of Ex-Servicemen in each subject. The unfilled seats, if any reserved for SC will be filled in by admitting ST candidates and vice versa as per the Indian Constitution.
- b) Reserved seats shall be deemed to be unreserved if these seats are not filled in by the respective candidates in time.

How to apply:

- a) Application form along with the prospectus can be had from the college office on payment of Rs. 300/-
- b) Duly completed application form together with required testimonials/certificates are to be submitted to the College office on or before the last date of submission notified by the Principal.
- c) Incomplete application forms submitted after the last date shall be rejected and for which no claim shall be entertained.

Enclosures required along with the application form at the time of submission:

- a) Two photo copies of mark sheets both for High School leaving Certificate Examination and Higher Secondary Examination duly attested by a Gazetted Officer/Self.
- b) Two photo copies of Admit Cards both for High School leaving Certificate Examination and Higher Secondary Examination duly attested by a Gazetted Officer/Self.
- c) Three copies of latest passport size photographs.
- d) Latest Original Income Certificate from the competent authority.
- e) Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/OBC/MU shall submit an attested copy of the latest Caste/Tribe/OBC/OBC/MU certificate issued by the concerned Deputy Commissioner.
- f) For handicapped candidates and student having two years or more study break, a court affidavit shall be submitted along with the application forms.
- g) In case of students other than COHSEM, original migration certificate should be submitted.
- h) One photo copy of aadhar card.
- i) Registration certificate(Original) both for CBSE & COHSEM.
 - N.B. i) No quota for admission under pressure from any union or association etc.
 - ii) No downloaded mark sheet is allowed.

DISCIPLINE:

The college maintains a high standard of discipline in all the activities in the campus. The student should follow the rules & regulations of the college.

Rules for students:

The students are required:

- 1. to wear college uniform & to keep decency of dress.
- 2. to attend class regularly & to pay respect to their teachers and elders.
- 3. to speak softly and politely & not to indulge in eve teasing.
- 4. not to loiter in and around the verandah & not to sit on the parked vehicles.
- 5. not to damage any college property.
- 6. to switch off mobile phone in the class rooms.
- 7. to carry College Identity card by every students.
- 8. to make the entire campus an Intoxication Free Zone.
- 9. to preserve communal harmony and foster it by word and deed.
- 10. Ragging is strictly prohibited.
- 11. As per UGC rules, students are mandatory to attend the induction programme before the commencement of the new classes (Session).

Important information:

Ragging means the following:

Any conduct spoken or written or by any act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness to any other student, indulging in rowdy or un disciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension there of to a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary circumstances and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment, so as to adversely affect the physical & psychological wellbeing of a fresher or a junior student.

Punishment:

When a person commit or abet the crime of ragging the Anti-Ragging Committee of the college will punish the student depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence.

FACILITIES

Library:

The college has a fully automated central library and also various departmental libraries. The central library has more than 14,000 books. Computers are available with internet facility in the central library. Photocopy machines are installed in the administrative block & library at concessional rates for the convinience of the students.

Students' common Room:

The College has separate boys' and girls' common rooms for the students to relax in their leisure hours. Students can avail facilities like newspapers, periodicals, Journals, various indoor games etc. in the said common rooms.

Canteen:

The college has a canteen providing tea, coffee, fruit juice & snacks to students and staff at reasonable price.

Drinking water:

Having installed " water purifying machines", the college provides clean, hygienic and cold drinking water.

Internet and computer facilities:

The college has a computer central lab. To enhance the quality of the students, classes on computer applications such as Mathematica, Programming etc. are conducted from time to time in this computer lab. The college campus is Wi-Fi enabled. Students can avail the facility of online submission of application forms for different jobs and competitive examinations. Most of the classromms are well equipped with Smart boards & LCD projectors.

Hostel:

The college has two boys' hostels providing accommodation to 80 students. Students can apply for hostel accommodation only after admission.

24X7 power supply:

With the installation of a 25KVA transformer, the college has a facility of regular power supply round the clock. To augument & save energy, an additional 10KW solar project has been installed, which has been providing clean energy and friendly to the environment.

Alumni:

The college has an active Alumni Association called Modern College Alumni Association (MCCA) which was established in the year 2002. The Association is registered under the Manipur Societies Registration Act, 1989. A permanent office is maintained within the College campus to organise the activities of the association.
